Ms Bennett presented information about the ICAC Evaluation of the Practices, Policies & Procedures of Super SA.

Ms Bennett was very positive in her presentation and spoke to the progress made on the ICAC evaluation. Ms Bennett highlighted that Super SA is working with the Department of Treasury and Finance (DTF) on a joint implementation plan to address the 24 evaluation recommendations, noting that these recommendations were also identified through an internal audit process.

Ms Bennett assured members that their management processes were comparable with APRA funds.

Ms Bennett indicates that she welcomes the Objectives of Legislation legislation. The presentation was very positive and questions from members were addressed confidently. It must be noted that:

The evaluation considered whether Super SA's practices, policies and procedures provide adequate controls to manage corruption risks.

The evaluation did not examine the investment of superannuation funds, which is managed by Funds SA.


